Join us on Saturday evening for a 'spine-tingling' murder mystery dinner theatre event at the beautiful Christian W. Klay Winery in Chalk Hill, PA. In addition to an intriguing and interactive mystery play, the evening includes a complimentary wine tasting and a delicious buffet dinner. The wine tasting starts promptly at 6 p.m.

The Christian W. Klay Winery is located in western Pennsylvania's beautiful Laurel Highlands (about 1½ hours from downtown Pittsburgh). Each wine from the Christian W. Klay award-winning collection carries the name of an historic site situated along America's first turnpike - the National Road. The winery is just minutes from historic sites, gourmet dining, and recreational activities; including white water rafting, horseback riding, spelunking, camping, biking, hiking, skiing, and golfing.

Consider staying over Saturday night at The Lodge at Chalk Hill (2920 National Pike Rd [Rt. 40 East] Chalk Hill, PA 15421; 800-833-4283; <http://www.thelodgeatchalkhill.com>) just down the road from the Winery and enjoy the scenic Laurel Mountain area on Sunday. A double room, double occupancy runs \$83.00 for the night and includes a Continental breakfast from 7-10 a.m. (5% discount for AAA or AARP members [\$78.85]). There is plenty to do in the area – some of the featured attractions are listed below:

Jumonville (887 Jumonville Rd., Hopwood, PA 15445; just 7 minutes away from the Lodge at Chalk Hill) Come see the Great Cross of Christ standing 60 feet tall on Dunbar's Knob. On a clear day, the mountaintop boasts a view of three states and seven counties with sights up to 50 miles away. <http://www.jumonville.org>

Nemacolin Inn (1001 Lafayette Dr. Farmington, PA 15437; just 6 minutes away from the Lodge at Chalk Hill) <http://www.nemacolin.com> Eat lunch at The Tavern & play a game of billiards on their antique pool tables! If billiards isn't your thing, Nemacolin sports a Miniature Golf Course at their Adventure Center as well as bowling & arcade games at the WildSide. Or visit their Wildlife Center for a safari tour or horseback ride if you love animals!

### **Directions:**

From Pittsburgh (South) -- Follow Route 51 South to Route 40 East (Uniontown), turn right onto Route 40 East, continue Route 40 East approximately 14 miles. Turn right onto Fayette Springs Road at the Christmas Shop across from the Post Office. The winery is 300 yards on the left.

From Pittsburgh (Airport, West and North) -- Follow Route 60 South to I-79 South, I-79 South to I-70 East (Washington, PA), I-70 East to Route 43 South (California Exit), Route 43 South to Route 40 East (Brownsville); continue Route 40 East approximately 30 miles. Turn right onto Fayette Springs Road at the Christmas Shop across from the Post Office. The winery is 300 yards on the left.

From Pittsburgh (East) -- Follow the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Rt. 119 South (Exit 75 - New Stanton), take Route 119 South through Connellsville to Route 40 East (Uniontown), continue on Route 40 East approximately 14 miles. Turn right onto Fayette Springs Road at the Christmas Shop across from the Post Office. The winery is 300 yards on the left.
