Platinum-selling guitar virtuoso Robert Michaels is known for his dynamic Latin Jazz and Flamenco performances. Michaels, the son of Italian immigrants, started his musical career in his native Canada. There he was raised on and influenced by a variety of musical styles, from Jimmy Page, Carlos Santana, and Wes Montgomery to tango and jazz. In 1996, he released an independent debut album titled *Paradiso*, and followed it a second recording, *Arizona*, which earned him a nomination for a coveted Juno Award for Best Instrumental Artist of the Year. His third album, *Utopia*, was recorded for the Warner Music Canada label. For his Frick performance, Michaels will be accompanied by a bassist and drummer
