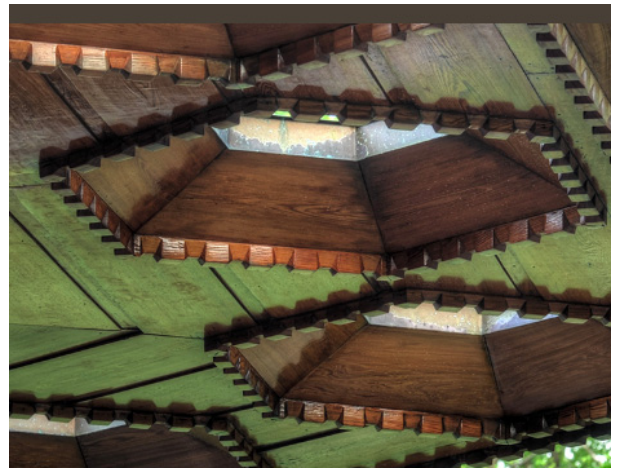

TOUR OF KENTUCK KNOB AND SCULPTURE GARDENS PLUS PICNIC AND BIKING (IF INTERESTED)

Kentuck Knob is a house designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1952 to integrate into the beautiful landscape. It was designed in the Usonian style for the average family and is located in the Laurel Highlands near Ohiopyle. The house tour lasts 40 minutes. Afterwards you can explore the Woodland Trail, an unguided trail that features sculptures along the way. Bring a picnic lunch and we will go to Ohiopyle State Park for a picnic by the falls. Make a day of it and bring your bike for a ride on the bike trail.

Mary Pitzer will make the reservations for the group. Walk-ins are accommodated last. Please arrive on time or before. Late comers will be asked to attend the next available tour time. Children under six years of age are not permitted on the house tour.

Directions:

Take PA-51 S approximately 42 miles. Turn right to merge onto US-119 S and go approximately 3.8 miles. Use the left two lanes to take the US-40 E exit towards Hopwood and go approximately 7.3 miles. Turn left onto Chalk Hill-Ohiopyle road and go approximately 3.2 miles. Turn right onto Kentuck Road and go approximately 3 miles to Kentuck Knob.
