

## Mount Snow, Vermont / Berkshire East, Massachusetts

A bus trip sponsored by WPSC – Sunday Jan. 26th to Friday Jan. 31, 2020

### Trip Includes:

- 5 Days and 5 nights at The Lodge at Mount Snow with full skiers breakfasts and dinners included.
- 5 Days of skiing, 1 day at Berkshire East in Mass., 4 days of skiing at Mount Snow, or 5 days at Mt. Snow.
- 3 Nights of entertainment.
- Tuesday – wine and cheese après ski party.
- Bus driver tip.

### Cost:

- **Single - \$1,060; Double - \$760; Triple - \$740; Quad - \$720**  
As in the past, if you request a double and do not have a roommate, one will be assigned. Should a second person not be available, you will receive a single room, but will be charged at the lower double rate.
- **Triples and Quad are available upon request - not assigned.**

### Discounts:

- **Non-Skier;** Deduct \$155.00
- **Senior Skier/ Boarder;** Deduct - \$15.00 from listed cost.
- **Bus transportation not required;** Mt. Snow - deduct \$150.00
- **Vouchers for Mt. Snow;** Let me know how many day lift ticket (1, 2, or 3) you will need.

### Payments due as Follows:

- A Reservation Form is required for each person / couple.
- **All trip participants must be a current member of a Ski Club.** (I will be checking with ski clubs for membership.) If you are a member of a ski club outside of the WPSC, please include the name and phone number of your membership officer.
- Initial deposit of \$100.00 per person sent with Reservation Form to hold your space; 50% due by Nov. 15th, with remainder due by Jan. 5th, 2020. Additional Payments can be made at any time.
- **Cancellations** will be charged a \$25.00 cancellation fee. Cancellations after January 1st, 2020 may not be accommodated and refunds may not be available. Cancellations after January 1st will be assessed a \$50 cancellation fee plus any costs incurred by the Council. **Absolutely, No changes in lift tickets after January 15th, Due to advance lift ticket purchases.**

### New Changes for this Year

- The first 40 bus travelers will receive the rates listed above. After that, the rates will be higher to pay for the second bus and will come down as more people sign up. There is a 20 rider minimum for a second bus.
- The trip will be closed on January 1, 2020. No reservations will be accepted postmarked after December 31, 2019.
- A \$25 late fee will be charged when final payment is received 10 days after the due date January 5, 2020. A notice will be sent 5 days before the date due.

### Western Pennsylvania Ski Council Release Form

**Statement of Purpose:** The Western Pennsylvania Ski Council provides services such as ski trips and activities as a benefit to member clubs through the participation of volunteer leaders who receive no discounts or compensation for their services. Said leaders are not professionally trained, but undertake the trip/activity leadership to the best of their knowledge and ability and spend many hours during and off-season, organizing, arranging, and leading trips and events.

#### Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement to the Western Pennsylvania Ski Council

I, the below named individual, being 21 years of age or older, in consideration of services which have or will be performed by the Western PA. Ski Council, in providing travel arrangements and activities and of being permitted to participate in the Council trips, activities, events and other functions which I recognize as being hazardous, do for myself, my personal representatives, and next of kin:

- (1) **hereby** release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue or hold liable the Western PA. Ski Council, its officers, directors, event leaders and trustees, all for the purposes herein, referred to as Releases, from all loss or damage and any claims or demands therefore, on account of injury to the or property, or resulting in death, whether caused by the negligence of Releases or otherwise, while for any purpose participating in any event or activity; and
- (2) **hereby** agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless the Release from any loss, liability, damage, or the cost they may incur to my presence and or participating during any activity, and whether caused by the negligence of the Release or otherwise; and
- (3) **hereby** assume full responsibility for any risk of bodily damage, death or property damage due to negligence of Release or otherwise while traveling, participating or for any purpose while engaged in such activities. I expressly agree that the foregoing Release, Waiver and Indemnity Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted in the state, states, and countries in which the activity is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

I have read and voluntarily signed the Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement, which shall remain in full legal force and effect until such time that I notify the Western PA Ski Council in writing that this agreement is voided.
